

## Cost of Common AC Repairs

There are plenty issues that come up with any AC unit and fortunately, there are agreed-upon ranges for each and every one. While some of these projects may cost more than \$900, just know that you can always reduce the price by shopping around for the right HVAC contractor.

Refrigerant Leak Repair: \$200 – \$1,500 AC

Refrigerant Recharge: \$250 – \$750

Control Circuit Boards: \$100 – \$590

Fuses, Circuit Breakers or Relays: \$75 – \$290

New Thermostat: \$115 – \$470

Outdoor Condensing Unit Fan Motor: \$200 – \$650

Condensate Drain Line Flush: \$75 – \$250

Compressor Replacement: \$1,350 – \$2,300

Replacement Condensing Unit Coil: \$1,900 – \$2,900

Metal or Plastic Drain Pans: \$250 – \$575

Condensate Pump Replacement: \$240 – \$450

Condenser Fan Motor: \$450 - \$750
